

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
COVID-Related Outpatient Visits: 7-Day Average


COVID-Related Emergency Department Visits: 7-Day Averages

Patient Concern or Symptoms








COVID - 19 | Daily Hospitalizations and ICU Admissions by Date Reported

COVID-19 | Cases vs. Testing: Percent Increases in Past Month




LEVEL 3


Public Emergency
